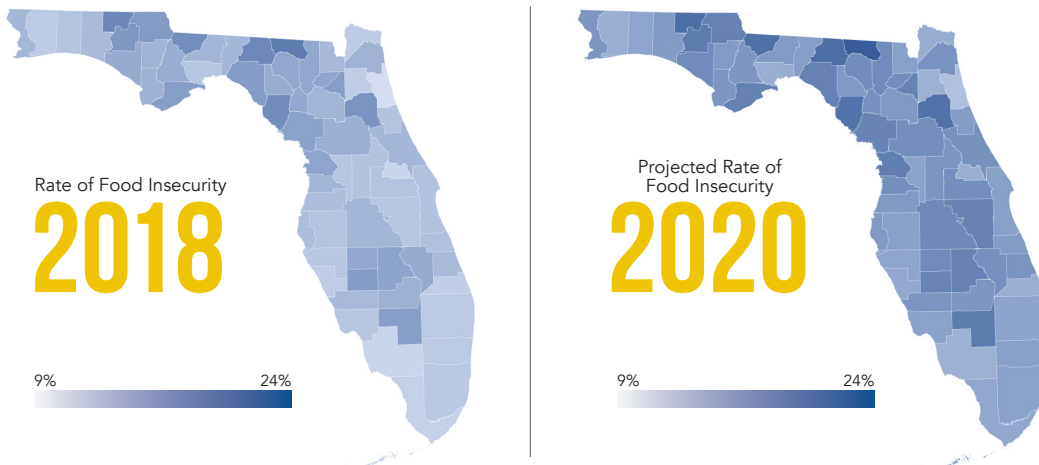
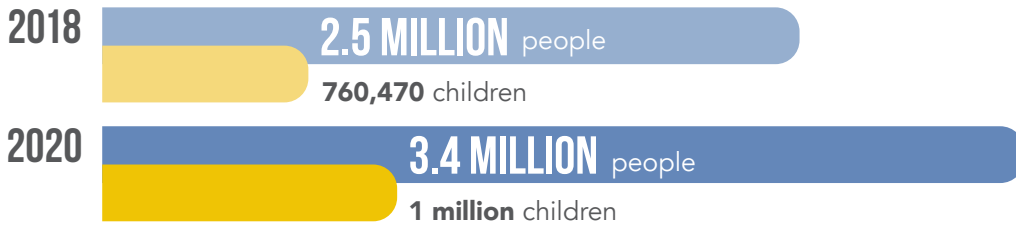


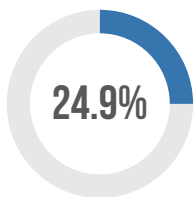

FOOD INSECURITY IN FLORIDA 2018 VS. 2020

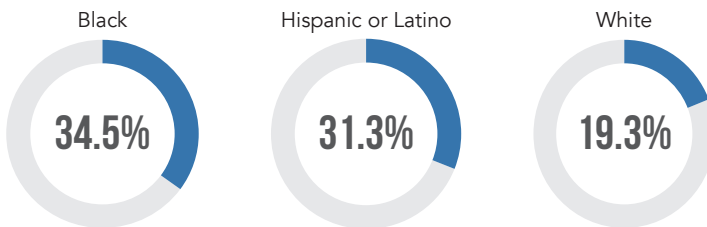


RATE OF HOUSEHOLD FOOD INSECURITY BY RACE/ETHNICITY, MAY 5–JULY 21, 2020

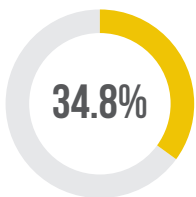

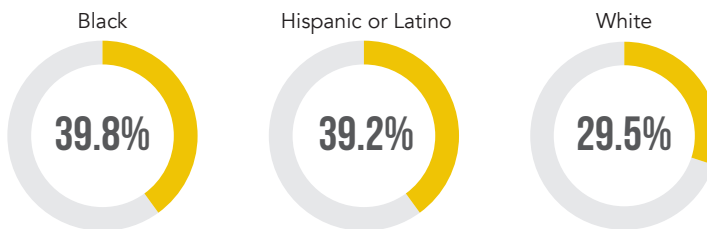

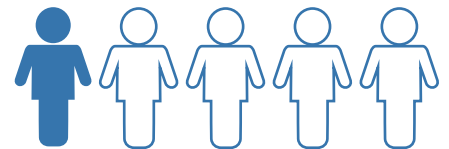

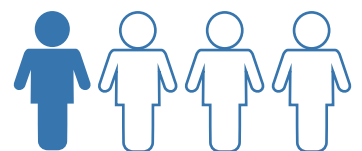
COVID-19's economic impact has dramatically increased food insecurity, especially among children.
